#### ANNUAL SCHOOL EXHIBITION – ABHIVYAKTI

The annual Science Exhibition 'Abhivyakti' was held on 23rd February 2022 in which the students of classes VI to VIII participated enthusiastically and displayed their creativity. The students were required to demonstrate models based on topics which they have studied during their curriculum. They presented both still & working models depicting various themes during the exhibition. The parents were invited to visit the exhibition following all the SOPs of Covid -19 protocol. The major attractions of the exhibition were lunar landing, 3D solar system and biodiversity point. The lunar landing was exhibited using a pulley system. # **Nutshell**


































## L'anvas
